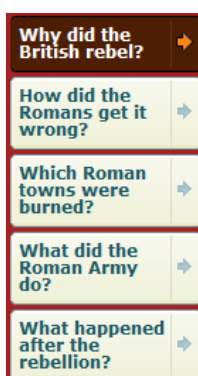
UNDERSTANDING THE BOUDICA REBELLION AND ITS EFFECT ON LONDON

Introduction activity

With the class, outline the main elements of the events that led up to, and the events after, the invasion of London by Boudica.

Use the BBC Primary History Roman site located [here](#) to re-tell the events.

Main part of the lesson

Use the 'Boudican rebellion resource' sheet and explain to the class that this has the events of the rebellion all mixed up.

Explain that the first activity is that the class are to re-order the events.

This can be done either using the computer and the pupils using the 'cut, copy and paste' tools to re-order, or use the resource as an offline activity.

Discuss with the class what the differing opinions and feelings of the two different armies must have been. The Iceni must have been angry at the Roman army for their treatment as they were demanding more taxes and they wanted Boudica to give up her throne. The Roman army must have also been angry as their Roman town of Londinium was destroyed and many Britons and Romans were killed.
